

COVID-19 POLICIES

Please be aware that, due to the rapidly evolving nature of the COVID-19 pandemic, specific items in this policy are subject to change to align with federal, state, local, and convention center or hotel guidelines. Please check our website for the most up-to-date version of these policies and procedures.

Vaccination

You must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 to attend Furvana 2021.

Following the **CDC definition**, you are fully vaccinated: 2 weeks after your second dose of any combination of WHO-approved vaccines that require 2 doses, **OR** 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine. We will not ask you for proof of vaccination as a condition of receiving your proof of membership (badge). However, if you are not, for your safety and the safety of others, we respectfully ask that you not attend Furvana 2021 — we'd love to see you in the future when it's safer.

Making, causing to be made, or using false or misleading documents or claims regarding one's vaccination status is a violation of our Code of Conduct. Because of the unique and elevated risk that this poses to public safety, anyone found to be attempting to circumvent this policy may receive a lifetime ban from Furvana events.

At this time, because the United States Food and Drug Administration has not authorized any COVID-19 vaccines for children under the age of 12, children under the age of 12 should not attend Furvana 2021.

Show us your vaccination record at the con store to get a free "Vaccinated" ribbon. These are not required, but they are a fun way to show your support for public health!

Face masks

Convention center policy requires that all occupants, including those wearing fursuits or costumes, wear masks inside the venue. Your mask must cover your nose and mouth. No chin diapers! Your fursuit head by itself doesn't qualify as a mask, sorry. Please wear a mask under your fursuit head.

Masks are not required for outdoor events, but still recommended, especially if you're going to be in close proximity with other people.

If you don't have a mask, we will have a limited supply of disposable masks and we will be happy to provide one to you free of charge. You can also check out our Dealers' Den, where some of our talented dealers may have custom masks for sale!

Wristbands

We will have free colored wristbands at Con Store that you can wear on your wrist or lanyard to indicate your comfort:

Green: OK to be close! (As usual, get consent to touch!)

Yellow: Ask to approach!

Red: Keep your distance!

Physical distancing

- Please try to maintain 6 feet (2 meters) of distance from others, especially when you are around people you don't live with.
- We've reduced the room capacity for several convention features.
- Panels are limited to seated capacity only. No standing room, sorry.
- The Dealers' Den has fewer dealers this year to allow for more space between tables.
- During busy hours we may have additional capacity limitations.
- You may see similar changes in other function spaces as well.

Sanitation

Hand sanitizer will be available in various areas of the convention center. Please feel free to use frequently, in conjunction with washing your hands. Additional sanitization procedures will be in place around the convention, particularly in the fursuit lounge and the gaming room. The panel room will be cleaned after each panel. Disposable gloves will be available for use in the gaming room.

The convention center is equipped with MERV-13-rated air filters.










BEACH SAFETY

Furvana is located a very short walk from the coast of the beautiful Pacific Ocean, and although there is plenty of fun to be had on the beach, the ocean can be extremely dangerous if you do not respect the power of the waves. To ensure a fun and safe time is had by all, please follow these guidelines whenever you're on the beach:

- Logs Are Not Your Friends! Always stay clear of driftwood logs and never play on or around them. Logs
 are on the beach because they were picked up and carried by waves; they are unstable and can easily
 roll over on you.
- Knee Deep! If you do walk into the water, make sure you don't go in to water past your knees to help
 ensure your safety and help prevent you from being swept away by a rip current.
- **Bring a Buddy!** Do not go out close to or into the water by yourself. That way, if you do get into trouble, there will always be someone to call for help.
- **Don't Turn Your Back on the Ocean!** When in the water, sneaker waves can come out of nowhere and knock you off your feet. Always keep one eye on the incoming waves when in the water or close to the water's edge.
- **Wear a Wetsuit!** The water of the Pacific Ocean can be very cold, especially in September! Wearing a wetsuit will help keep your body temperature regulated and decrease the risk of hypothermia.
- Cars on the Beach The beach is classified as a state highway, so pedestrians should watch out for
 moving vehicles at all times and vehicles should drive slowly and be very mindful of pedestrians. Driving
 on the packed sand of the beach is permitted, but you should always stay very clear of the ocean water. It
 is very easy for a heavy vehicle to become entrapped in the wet sand, and the high salt content of ocean
 water can do damage to a vehicle. Traction tires are strongly advised.
- Alcohol Alcohol is permitted on the beach, but you MUST NOT be in a vehicle if you are drinking.
- Leave only pawprints, take only memories! Please clean up after yourself. Remember that the beach is connected to the habitats of the surrounding wildlife.



OUR CHARITY

PAWS of Grays Harbor is the largest no-kill animal shelter in Grays Harbor County. PAWSGH was established as a nonprofit in 1973, and each year helps more than 3,000 animals. In addition to rescue, adoption, and humane education, PAWSGH also provides numerous services to the community, including low-cost spay/neuter, Community Care (vaccines, flea treatments, grooming services at discounted rates), and a free Pet Food Pantry (which has already given away over 1,000 pounds of food thus far this year).

Community Involvement:


PAWSGH wants to keep dogs and cats safe not only at the shelter, but also in the community. Humane Education is a key component of PAWSGH's mission — because better educated pet owners are more responsive pet owners. As well, many folks in the community are struggling financially, and PAWSGH wants to make certain their pets have the best care possible, which is part of the Community Care philosophy. Flea treatments, de-worming pills, vaccines, nail trims, and even pet baths are all available at steeply discounted rates for everyone. Healthy pets are happy pets! PAWSGH also operates a Pet Food Pantry that is on pace to distribute over 2,000 pounds of nutritious, high-quality pet food for free to members of the community in 2021.

Teamwork — Because Every Animal Matters:

PAWSGH houses dogs and cats but doesn't shy away from helping other animals in need. Last April, Seattle's Animal Shelter requested help from PAWSGH in finding forever homes for some of the 270+ rabbits they had rescued from a terrible hoarding situation. PAWSGH, with the assistance of multiple partners — including the Grays Harbor County Fairgrounds and the local 4-H and FFA groups — was able to care for them until they were all successfully adopted to loving homes.
